# Foundation Legacy Endowment Group (LEG)

Establishing a Kansas Pharmacy Legacy

#### What It Is

In the early 2000's, the Kansas Pharmacy Foundation (KPF) in collaboration with Pharmacists Mutual Insurance Company established the KPF Legacy Endowment Group (LEG). The purpose of the LEG is to establish a means of support for the Foundation to sustain our profession in Kansas.

Each day, we contribute to our families, friends, community and society. It is important to recognize that today's successes are built on past contributions and dedication. A legacy is created from past experiences. A legacy grows during both good times and challenging times. It helps enable an organization to sustain itself.

KPF exists to enhance the welfare and integrity of the profession of pharmacy. It provides a means to memorialize and extend individual commitment to Kansas pharmacy. Your contribution to the LEG is a way to have a direct and lasting impact on the pharmacy profession.

The LEG is comprised of individuals who wish to provide an affordable gift of life insurance to KPF. Your commitment of life insurance will provide a substantial deferred gift with modest annual contributions over twelve years. The annual premium is tax deductible as it is paid to KPF, an IRS approved 501 c (3) charitable organization. The LEG will help assure KPF the long-term reality of enriching and building the heritage of Kansas pharmacy. Each of these insurance policies will go to support the many goals and activities now and into the future.

## **How It Works**

The life insurance policies will be issued to the members of this group based upon what a premium of \$500 will purchase at their current age and health. These premiums will be payable over a 12-year period. After 12 years the policies will be paid-up, meaning no future premiums will be due, but the policies will continue until the insured's death. Upon the death of the member, KPF will receive the proceeds to support the future of the KPF organization.
